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Day 1 - Portage, IN – Today, travel takes you to Portage, IN for an overnight stay at the Country Inn & Suites. Dinner is included this evening at Texas Roadhouse. (D)

Day 2 - Air Zoo Aerospace Museum – London, ON – Tree Trunk Tour – After breakfast, stop in Kalamazoo, MI at the Air Zoo

Aerospace Museum featuring more than 50 rare and historic aircraft, amusement park-style rides, Full-Motion Flight Simulators, RealD 3D/4D Missions Theater, as well as historical exhibits.

Then cross into Canada and arrive on London, ON. Enjoy a Tree Trunk Tour which demonstrates London, Ontario's love of trees and is enhancing its reputation as the "Forest City". Carvers have created sculptures that, instead of being confined to an art gallery, are right out on the public streets. End the day by checking into the Best Western Plus Stoneridge Inn for the night. Dinner is included at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 3 – Niagara Falls, ON – The Chocolate Factory – Bella Terra Vineyards Tour & Tasting – Living Water Wayside Chapel – Niagara Adventure Theatre – Arrive this morning in Niagara Falls, ON where you meet your local guide for a full day of touring. Start with a visit to The Chocolate Factory, Niagara's choice for premium artisanal craft chocolate.

Next, visit Bella Terra Vineyards for a tour and tasting. This family-owned winery has been handed down from one generation to the next. As you sip any one of Bella Terra's wines, you are tasting three generations of grape-growing and winemaking experience.

Then visit the Living Water Wayside Chapel, an interesting sight in the town of Niagara-on-the-Lake. It was built in 1964 by the Christian Reformed Church. It is the smallest church in Canada and is also claimed by some to be the smallest in the world. No bigger than a one-car garage, it has become a destination for visitors to stop for photographs and prayers.

The afternoon also includes a visit to the Niagara Adventure Theatre. Experience the magic of cinema that helped recreate the stories of the daredevils who dared to see Niagara Falls as something to be conquered. The Niagara: Miracles, Myths & Magic Movie offers you a window into Niagara Falls' sensational true stories including the death-defying daredevils that attempted to challenge the roaring and treacherous waters.

Dinner is included this evening at the Summit Suite Buffet. Located 775 feet above the Falls, the Summit Suite Buffet provides the best view of Niagara Falls. End the day by checking into the Comfort Inn Fallsview for a two-night stay.

The hotel a 5 minutes' walk from the majestic Horseshoe Falls, as well as the Rainbow International Bridge, Victoria Ave. Midway, and Skylon Tower. (B, D)

Day 4 – Table Rock – Journey Behind the Falls – Voyage to the Falls Boat Tour – Oakes Garden Theatre – Niagara Parks Power Station – Niagara Parkway Drive - Wild Magic Illusion Dinner Show – After breakfast, visit the Table Rock Welcome Center, a retail and observation complex located at the brink of the Canadian Horseshoe Falls, several hundred feet south of the former rock formation which bears its name. Here you will have time for photos of the three waterfalls at the southern end of Niagara Gorge, spanning the border between the province of Ontario in Canada and the state of New York in the United States.

Next, take a Journey Behind the Falls. To stand at the heart of Niagara, you'll first need to descend 125 feet and explore 130-year-old tunnels through the bedrock, but you'll feel the thunderous vibration of the Horseshoe Falls long before you see them. The observation deck at the foot of this 13-story-tall wonder will leave you breathless (and maybe a little bit wet), but don't forget the viewing portals cut straight through the rock, offering a once-in-a-lifetime view of one-fifth of the world's fresh water crashing down in front of you.

Then enjoy the Voyage to the Falls boat tour. Enjoy stunning views of the Niagara Gorge, American Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls, and come face-to-face with the famous Canadian Horseshoe Falls. Feel the thundering roar, awesome power, and amazing mist (a protective souvenir mist poncho is provided) that come along with these natural wonders.

Following the boat tour, stop at the Secret Garden Restaurant & Gift Shop, Niagara's best kept secret. The dining room is literally embraced by the manicured, floral splendor of Niagara Parks' luxuriant Oakes Garden Theatre and provides breathtaking views of the American Falls. Lunch will be on your own here today.

Then stroll through Oakes Garden Theatre, a curved pergola overlooking a central amphitheater. The shaded lily ponds and formalized gardens offer visitors a tranquil escape in the heart of Niagara Falls. Bordered by ornamental iron gates and Queenston limestone, Oakes Garden Theatre provides a spectacular entranceway to Queen Victoria Park at the foot of Clifton Hill.

Today also features a visit to the Niagara Parks Power Station, a revived, former hydroelectric plant that now serves as a historic landmark and tourist attraction. Explore the original generator floor, take a glass-lined elevator down into a historic underground tunnel, and enjoy the



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"Currents" night show, a multimedia experience showcasing the station's history and the power of Niagara Falls.

The attraction features immersive exhibits, restored artifacts, and a riverside observation deck, celebrating the station's legacy as a pioneer in long-distance hydroelectric power transmission.

Then enjoy a scenic drive on the Niagara Parkway where you will pass various points of interest. Enjoy a quick stop at the Whirlpool Aero Car and the most photographed attraction in Niagara Falls, the Floral Clock.



End the day with the Wild Magic Dinner and Show at the Greg Frewin Theatre. Experience the mystery and art of illusion with Greg Frewin, one of the most decorated magicians in the world. Enjoy an evening performance of a Las Vegas Style Magical Revue featuring spectacular appearances by our rare and majestic tigers. Your IMAGINATION will be captivated, and you will be AMAZED beyond belief. (B, D)

Day 5 - Toronto, ON – Casa Loma – Toronto Driving Tour – St. Lawrence Market – Historical Distillery District of Toronto – CN Tower – Hamilton, ON – After breakfast, depart for Toronto, ON. Start with a visit to Casa Loma, Canada's Majestic Castle. Step back in time to a period of European elegance and splendor. The former home of Canadian financier Sir Henry Pellatt, Canada's foremost castle is complete with decorated suites, secret passages, an 800-foot tunnel, towers, stables, and beautiful 5-acre estate gardens.

Next, meet your local guide for a scenic driving tour of Toronto. Here your guide will share points of interest, historical sights and museums of the city. Stop at the Lawrence Market for lunch on your own. This iconic landmark is a culinary hotspot featuring more than 120 merchants and farmers in three buildings. There are many restaurants, artisans and specialty food vendors offering visitors the unique and lively atmosphere of an authentic farmers' market.

Then visit the Historic Distillery District, a pedestrian-only village that was once home to the Gooderham and Worts Distillery, Canada's largest distillery. Today, it is a popular hub for arts, culture, entertainment, unique shopping, and award-winning restaurants, and it's free to visit and explore its Victorian industrial architecture.

Today also includes a visit to the CN Tower. Discover spectacular views, from the LookOut Level at 1,136 ft, including EdgeWalk viewing at BaseCamp 3.0, dare to walk on air on the world-famous Glass Floor at 1,122 ft. with outdoor SkyTerrace, and more.

End the day in Hamilton, ON for an overnight stay at the Sheraton Hamilton Hotel. Dinner is on your own this evening. (B)

Day 6 - Frankenmuth, MI – After breakfast, head to Frankenmuth, MI. On arrival, enjoy lunch at the Bavarian Inn Restaurant known for its World-Famous family-style chicken meals, and authentic German cuisine. Enjoy an exterior with woodcarving, flower boxes, and the 35-bell carillon atop the 50-foot Glockenspiel.

Then stop at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland, the world's largest Christmas Store. The sights, sounds, and spirit of CHRISTmas completely surround you at this amazing store, which is the size of one and a half football fields. Bronner's is overflowing with 50,000 trims and gifts.

Depart this afternoon for Ludington, MI where you enjoy an overnight stay at the Holiday Inn Express. Dinner will be on your own this evening. (B, L)

Day 7 – SS Badger Ferry to Manitowoc, WI – Lunch at The Wharf – Depart for Home –

This morning after breakfast, board the SS Badger Ferry. Enjoy a relaxing 4-hour trip between Ludington, Michigan and Manitowoc, Wisconsin. There is plenty to see and do aboard the huge ship – including games, free movies and satellite television, shopping in the gift shop, or just strolling or lounging on the spacious outside decks. Once you arrive in Manitowoc, WI, enjoy an included lunch at The Wharf before departing for home. (B,L)



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
