Kentucky Horses & Spirits

6 Days September 26 to October 1, 2026

Day 1 – Hammond, IN – Today, travel takes you to Hammond, IN where you enjoy an overnight stay at the Holiday Inn Express. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **(D)**

Day 2 – Lexington, KY – Kentucky Horse Park – Old Kentucky Nights w/Dinner & Horses – After breakfast, depart for Lexington, KY. Once you arrive in Lexington this afternoon, visit the Kentucky Horse Park. Most places can only tell you stories about legends, but at Kentucky Horse Park, they may just trot right by you. This park is self-guided and hands-on, so you can touch the horses, smell the hay and see first-hand the majesty of the horse. This is a place for all of your senses!

Tonight, enjoy Old Kentucky Nights, an exclusive, after-hours program that showcases the beauty and serenity of the Kentucky Horse Park's grounds. This private, evening program provides you with an opportunity to tour the facility and enjoy some famous Kentucky hospitality in the heart of Bluegrass horse country. Dinner will be included. You will also have the change to get "up close and personal" with two horses in the courtyard before dinner. End the day by checking into the Hampton Inn for a two-night stay. **(B,D)**

Day 3 - Keeneland Morning Works Tour w/Breakfast – Free Time – Woodford Reserve Distillery – Woodsongs Old-Time Radio Hour – Start this morning at Keeneland to experience early morning workouts and enjoy breakfast at the Track Kitchen. Get an up-close look at this National Historic Landmark with a tour of Keeneland. On this outside walking tour, your experienced tour guide will take you through the Keeneland paddock, grandstand, grounds, and, when available, to the world-renowned Keeneland Sales Pavilion. You'll learn more about this pillar of the equine industry in Kentucky and will likely see horses training on the track.

Then enjoy free time and lunch on your own at The Square. Located in the heart of downtown Lexington since the 1880's, you'll find an exciting and original mix of shopping, galleries, restaurants, bars, and more! This afternoon features a tour and tasting at the Woodford Reserve Distillery. You'll explore all five sources of flavor from grain to grass. For ages 21 and over, you will finish with a tasting of their award-winning craft bourbons and whiskies you'll truly experience the Woodford Reserve difference.

Dinner is included at a local restaurant. Following dinner, you have reserved seats for WoodSongs, a live audience syndicated public radio and public TV show, taping on Monday evenings from the historic Lyric Theatre. (WoodSongs is produced 44 Mondays a year). Each WoodSongs broadcast features brilliant, amazing musical artists from around the world. It's like a multi-media front porch that airs on 537 radio stations from Australia, across America to Ireland. It airs each weekend on American Forces Radio in 173 nations plus every military base and US Naval ship in the world. WoodSongs airs on public television from Los Angeles to Vermont and now each Friday on the RFD-TV Network. **(B, D)**

Day 4 - Mary Todd Lincoln House – Louisville, KY - Louisville Slugger Museum w/Bourbon Experience – Belle of Louisville Dinner Cruise - This morning after breakfast, enjoy a guided tour of the Mary Todd Lincoln House. Located in the heart of downtown, the Georgian-style brick house is one of the oldest structures in Lexington and the nation's first historic site to honor a First Lady. Childhood home of Mary Todd, wife of Abraham Lincoln, the home was restored to reflect the Todd family's residency with period furniture, family portraits and furnishings from the Todds as well as the Lincolns, taking you back to a time of social elegance and turbulent politics.

Following the tour, travel to Louisville, KY, where you will have time for lunch on your own on arrival. Then head to the Louisville Slugger Museum where you embark on the All About The Wood Package with Barrels & Billets. On this award-winning factory tour, witness the world-class museum gallery at Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory. Follow that up with Louisville's only custom bourbon blending experience at Barrels & Billets, located right next door to the museum.

This evening, enjoy a dinner cruise on the Mary M. Miller or the Belle of Louisville. Cruise into the evening as you take in the sights and sounds of the Ohio River while enjoying a delicious meal. End the day by checking into the Drury Inn for the night. **(B,D)**

Day 5 - Kentucky Derby Museum w/Lunch - Walking Tour of Churchill Downs – Hammond, IN – After breakfast, visit the Kentucky Derby Museum. You will have full access to the museum, including two floors of interactive exhibits. A viewing of the epic film, "The Greatest Race," a 360°, 18-minute media experience that will make your heart race and emotions soar. After your visit to the museum, enjoy a Guided Track Visit of Churchill Downs. Lunch is included at the Derby Cafe. This afternoon, travel to Hammond, IN for an overnight stay at the Holiday Inn Express. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **(B,L,D)**
