Scenic Driving View of the Enchanted Highway

The Enchanted Highway begins at Exit 72 on I-94 near Gladstone and terminates 32 miles down the road in the small town of Regent. Beginning with "Geese in Flight" at Exit 72, large metal sculptures are placed along the county highway, each with parking a area and kiosk except "Geese in Flight," which is viewable from adjacent interstate. Sculptures include "World's Largest Tin Family," "Teddy Rides Again," "Pheasants on the Prairie," "Grasshoppers in the Field," "Deer Crossing" and "Fisherman's Dream."

National Buffalo Museum

On our travel back home, you stop at The National Buffalo Museum is a 6000 square foot facility housed in a rustic log building at the Frontier Village in Jamestown, North Dakota. Museum exhibits focus primarily on the history of bison in the plains culture, but displays include Plains Indian artifacts; a wide variety of artwork; the 19th century firearms used by bison hunters; remains of prehistoric bison; and other wildlife of North Dakota.



Lunch stop on own in Fargo, North Dakota

You will return to Fargo for your lunch stop on your own. If you so choose, we may stop, once again, at the Brewhalle Market and visit the two floors and 60+ booths of local and regional makers in the Magic Factory and Odditorium that you might have missed the first time.



Tour the Runestone Museum

This afternoon visit The World Famous and controversial Kensington Runestone was the Runestone Museum's only artifact when it opened its' doors in 1958. Since then, the museum has grown to include additional artifacts found in Minnesota that relate to Middle-Age Nordic explorers. The 40 piece collection includes the Climax fire steel, found in Climax, Minnesota that was part of the Middle Age Nordic collection at the University Museum in Oslo long before the discovery of the Kensington Runestone. The Climax fire-steel is one of the only Middle Age Nordic fire steels on display in North America. Depart homeward after this visit - we will stop for dinner on your own enroute.

As the coach pulls into the parking lot, your drivers and cars await to gather you, your luggage and any treasures you might have gotten on the tour, whisking you home! (B)




